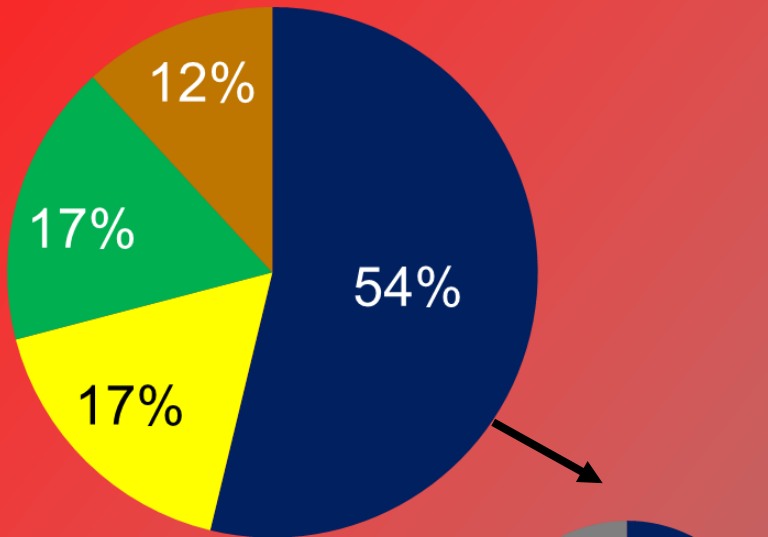


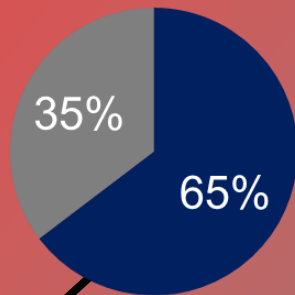


Have town citizens earned a 21st century economy?

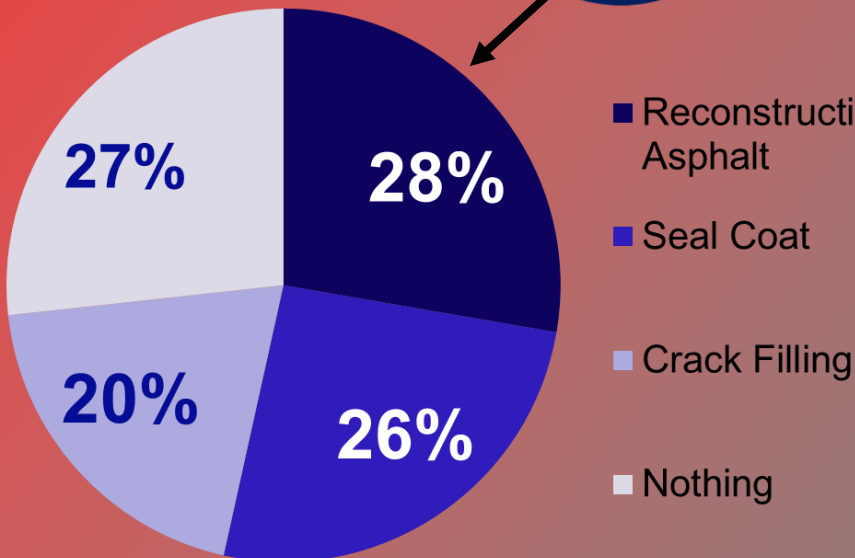
Or, will they be stuck with 20th century infrastructure?



Towns have 62,000 miles of roads that comprise 54% of the system



65% of town roads are paved, 35% are dirt or gravel



73% of town pavement needs major and expensive maintenance
