	Required Interval	Current
Crack Filling	3 Years	16.1 Years
Sealing	5 – 7 Years	31.4 Years
Mill – Overlay (mid-life treatment)	20 – 35 Years	62.9 Years
Reconstruction	40 – 70 Years	370.8 Years

Towns can reconstruct a road every 371 Years
